

TWIN PARISHES BUILDING COMMITTEE VOLUNTEERS

The building committee is vital to preserving and improving our place of worship: we are seeking new members. Members volunteer six to eight hours a month. They attend a monthly meeting, investigate maintenance needs, and sometimes perform some repairs. Membership on the committee is a two- to three-year commitment. Committee members are able to identify problems in the building and know how to fix them or whom to call to do the work. The committee also advises the pastor and Finance Committee on setting priorities for major projects and improvements. The committee consists of retired tradespeople, property managers, designers, people experienced managing renovations to their homes or businesses, and parishioners who are otherwise handy.
