

<u>St. Anthony Feast Day</u> 7: 00 pm Mass! Tuesday, June 13th Celebration Sunday, June 18th 10:30 am Mass, Procession & Potluck! Please bring food to share!

St. Anthony of Padua is best known as the finder of lost objects, but his life offers many lessons for us today.

Anthony (95-1231) began as a scholarly monk, but joined the new Franciscan Order to become a missionary friar. Chronic illness, however, kept Anthony from such an adventures and he was assigned to work in a friary kitchen. One day, he was called on to be a substitute preacher. He astonished the other friars by his humble eloquence and knowledge of the Bible.

Anthony cam to the attention of Saint Francis of Assisi. Francis was a charismatic and spiritual leader. and was suspicious of theological training - but Anthony change his mind. Soon Anthony became a great preacher and teacher. Anthony and other friars helped win back Catholics who had lapsed because of their frustration with priest and Church leaders. The Franciscans' mission of serving the poor also inspired other Christians to greater charity. The custom developed of celebrating the saint's feast by donating bread to the poor in gratitude to God for Anthony's intercession - the saint is often depicted with loaves. Today, instead of giving "St. Anthony's Bread" to show thanks for our many blessings, we can find other ways to share what we have with our brothers and sisters in need, near and far.

Importance of Registering with the Church Office

There are a number of parishioners who come to church regularly but are not officially registered. We need at least six months prior to requests for baptism, marriages, other sacraments and services. It assists us in determining how to deal with the request. If you have Sunday Collection Envelopes and a number for your church donation you are registered. FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Please call the parish office 780-432-0611 for more information and registration. Sessions will be every other Saturday from 10:00 am 12:000 PM at St. Agnes church hall. Deadline of registration is August 30, 2023.

CONFIRMATION PREPARATION CLASS –If your children are between the ages of 11 to 14, please call the parish office for more information and registration. Sessions will be every other Saturday at 1:00-3:00 PM at St. Agnes church hall. Deadline of registration is August 30, 2023

<u>RCIA</u> (Adapted for Children age 7 – 14) <u>**RCIA**</u> (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults – age 15 and above) Anyone who wants to become Catholic and Catholics who have not yet received First Communion and Confirmation, and anyone interested in learning more about RCIA please call parish office at 780-432-0611 to register. Session is every Wednesday @ 7:00 PM St. Anthony Padua Room.

MARRIAGE: Because the church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of **six months notice prior to the intended date of their wedding.** Normally the parish boundaries determine in which parish marriage planning should take place.

<u>FUNERAL</u>: Family or designated person by the family should contact the Parish Office for funeral arrangements with the parish priest.
