ABOUT OUR PASTOR, FR REGI MATHEW, OFM

Fr. Regi Mathew, OFM is an Indian Catholic priest of the Order of Friars Minor (OFM), commonly known as the Franciscans. Originally from the Indian state of Kerala, he has served in Canada since 2015, where he is known for his pastoral leadership, Franciscan spirituality, and ministry in multicultural communities. Presently he is the **Guardian of the Franciscan fraternity** in Edmonton and **Pastor of the Twin Parishes of St. Anthony and St. Agnes**.

Mission in Canada: Fr. Regi arrived in Canada in **2014** as part of the Canadian Franciscan mission. He initially served in Western Canada as a Hospital Chaplain for the Catholic Arch-Diocese of Edmonton and Associate Pastor for the Arch-Diocese of Vancouver before moving to Montreal in **2019**.

Pastoral Leadership: He became the **Guardian of the Franciscan fraternity** in Montreal's Parc-Extension neighborhood and **Pastor of Saint Francis of Assisi Parish**, one of Canada's most culturally diverse Catholic parishes. The parish serves faithful from numerous linguistic and cultural backgrounds, including French, English, Spanish, Vietnamese, and South Asian communities.

Multicultural Ministry: Fr. Regi is appreciated and recognized for fostering unity among people of different nationalities and cultures. He has spoken about the joy of celebrating the Eucharist with worshippers representing more than two dozen countries, viewing this diversity as a gift and an opportunity to build a welcoming Christian community.

Franciscan Spirituality: His ministry reflects the Franciscan ideals of peace, humility, fraternity, and outreach to those on the margins of society. He has encouraged Catholics to deepen their relationship with God by following the example of St. Francis of Assisi and living lives of compassion and service.

National Service: Fr. Regi currently serves as the **Chaplain of the Jesus Youth Canada National Council** for the **2026–2029** term. In this role, he provides spiritual guidance, pastoral care, and accompaniment fostering missionary discipleship to the National Council and the wider Jesus Youth movement in Canada.

Fr. Regi also serves as the **National Spiritual Assistant** to the Secular Franciscan Order in Canada, providing spiritual guidance and formation to Franciscan lay members across the country. He is the Chaplain of Jesus Youth National Council.

Retreats and pilgrimages: He also leads retreats and serves as a spiritual guide on pilgrimages to the Holy Land, helping pilgrims connect biblical sites with Christian faith and Franciscan tradition.

Fr. Regi Mathew is especially recognized and widely appreciated for his warm pastoral approach, commitment to intercultural ministry, and dedication to building welcoming faith communities where people from diverse backgrounds feel welcomed and valued. His ministry exemplifies His ministry reflects the Franciscan vision of living the Gospel through fraternity, hospitality, and service, making him a respected spiritual leader among Catholics in Canada and beyond.
