JUBILEE OF ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI



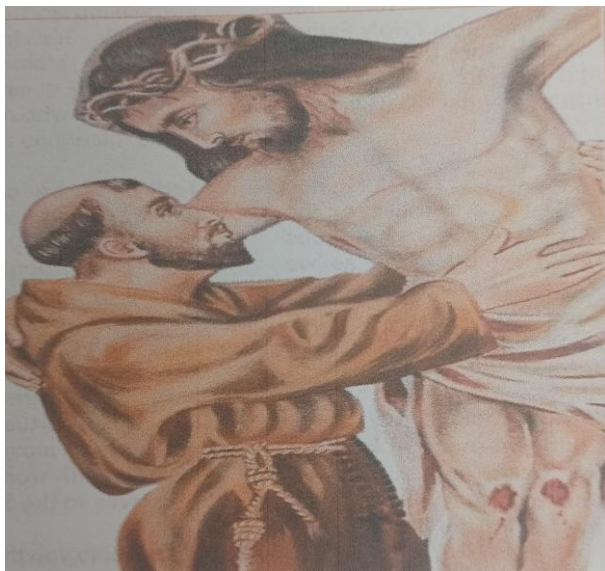

The relic is now in the small chapel of St Anthony Church at 10661-82 Avenue and is open to all pilgrims who wishes to pray and venerate. Our parish Pastor, Friar Regi Mathew, OFM, welcomes everyone who will visit the parish during mass times. For groups who are interested to visit the parish may contact the Office for arrangement. A guide on how to obtain indulgence can be found in the small chapel of St Anthony for all faithful to follow, including valuable reading materials about the great Saint.

From the Vatican:

Year of Saint Francis: "Indulgence is an encounter with God, not a spiritual shortcut"

The Regent of the Apostolic Penitentiary comments on the decree announcing plenary indulgences during the special Jubilee Year proclaimed by Pope Leo XIV on the occasion of the 800th anniversary of the Saint's death, stressing, "The Year of Saint Francis must not become yet another chapter rich in spiritual effects, but a silent passage from enthusiasm to deep maturity, from spectacular celebration to imitation in daily life."

We also quoted here excerpts of what Susan Campbell wrote in February 2026, about the Jubilee Year: "This Jubilee Year of grace invites us to find inspiration in the life and witness of St. Francis for our own journey of faith, so we also becoming models of holiness and constant witnesses of peace."



“May the Lord give you peace.”

Pope Leo highlights this famous greeting of St. Francis of Assisi and places the notion of “Peace” at the heart of this Jubilee year of grace. In his **prayer to St. Francis** asking for his special intercession, the Pope recalled that St. Francis was a person who sought and lived peace:

“Saint Francis, our brother, you who eight hundred years ago went to meet Sister Death as a man of peace, intercede for us before the Lord. You recognized true peace in the Crucifix of San Damiano, teach us to seek in Him the source of all reconciliation that breaks down every wall. You who, unarmed, crossed the lines of war and misunderstanding, give us the courage to build bridges where the world raises up boundaries. In this time afflicted by conflict and division, intercede for us so that we may become peacemakers: unarmed and disarming witnesses of the peace that comes from Christ.”

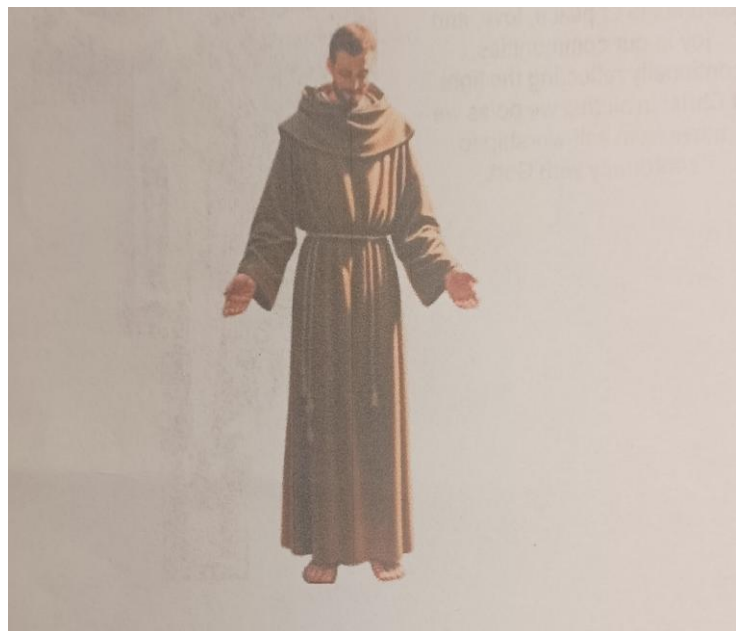
